# Procedures

- Accept new/changes of delegation only with correct configured servers.
- Check for correct delegation daily for domain names with problems and weekly for domain names without problems
- Track last date of correct answer and last date of verification (available at whois)
- Report to problems with instructions for correction to contacts bi-weekly



## Problem size / Solution

- ~ 450000 domain names, near 1000000 NS records.
- Daily checks near 20% of the domain names.
- Software checks 350 delegations/s, near to 10 minutes/day



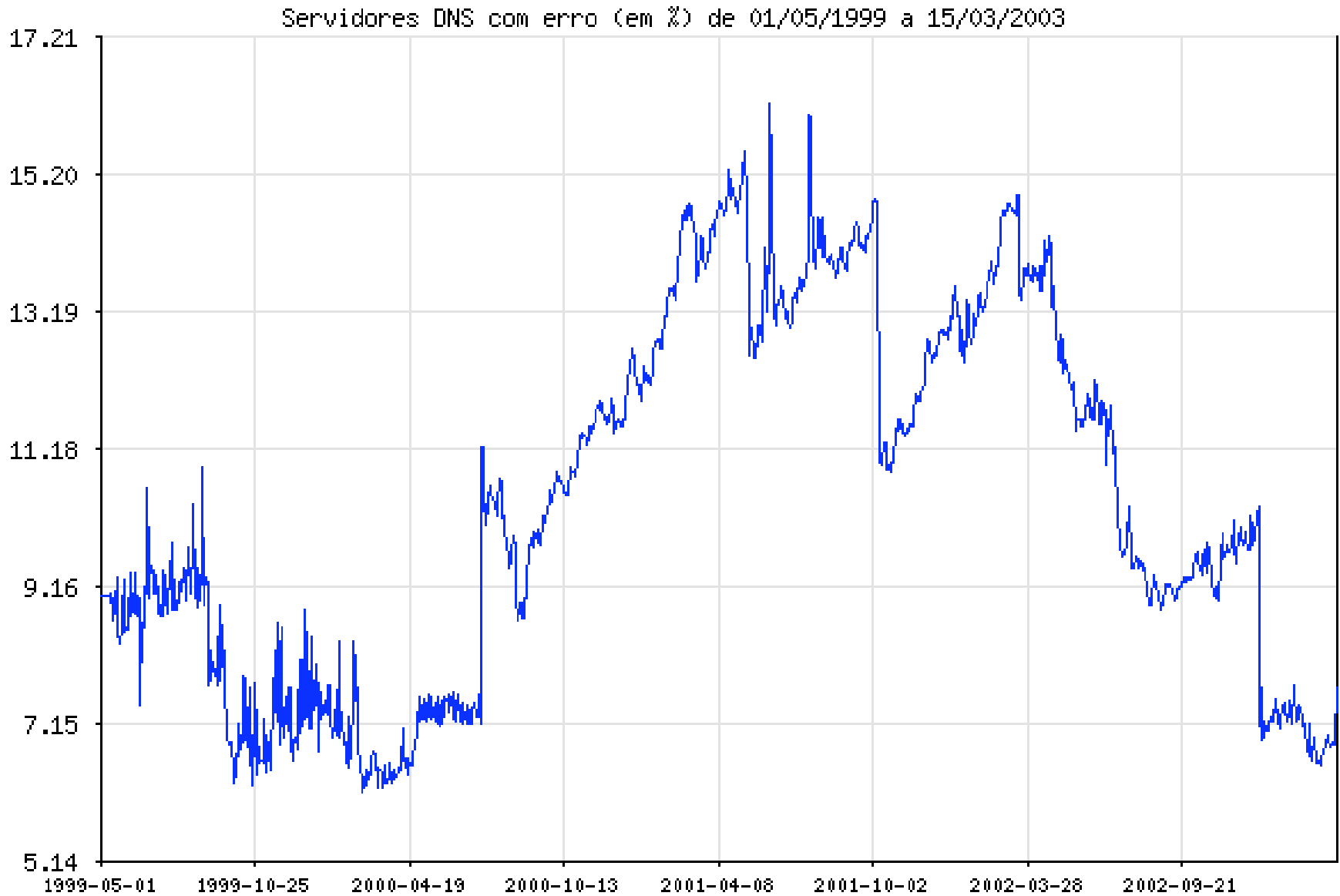
